
made it so easy for me to love you. When your health started to wane I knew I could cling onto the love and the memories to get us through it. Though at



6. CHAIRMAN REPORT 2022-2023 GM DUBE 21 OCTOBER 2023



We are fortunate to have 4 of our regions represented at the AGM, especially Ralph Jackson our National Vice Chairman and Athna de Jager the Western Cape Region Chairman. They both travelled 1,500 km from Cape Town and I feel they deserve applause for their effort. 9. ELECTION OF NEW COMMITTEE FOR THE FORTHCOMING YEAR.


The Constitution required the election of a Chairman, Vice Chairman,



Changes to Motorhome Policy Wording, Limits and Excesses:

There was previously no cover for:







It turned out impossible with the standard wheel spanner we had with us, to undo the nuts on the wheel. Some friendly Jimny owners stopped to assist, but without any success.



JJ and Juan joined us for the first time on a rally and we hope to see more of them. No lawn games were played but there was plenty of joviality, with quite




EAGLE VIEW MARBURG (20 – 22 OCTOBER 2023)


This was followed by a well-planned, tasty Build a Burger meal, supplied and organised by Linda and Thys Ellis. Saturday 21st



A wonderful weekend of fellowship and fun was enjoyed by all.
















NORTHVAAL REGION


Only four vans arrived Thursday and after setting up, we spent the day chatting and braaing together.

months.






George van der Merwe shared that on this day, 19th August, thirty years ago he joined the motorhome club. I wonder if anyone else can remeber the day they joined?


ing the annual AGM. Any proposals for new committee members must please be forwarded sooner rather than later so that they can be tabled at the AGM.



Over the weekend a further 2 motorhomes arrived and we also had another two who pitched during the week. Although they were not bowlers, they enjoyed the rally very much.


We also had guests from Meyerton, Div and Janita, who travelled every day to ensure that we had full teams for the week.

Trophies were awarded to Div and Janita who won the last man and woman competition.









JP and Rita from North Vaal joined us on our trip. They heard about our tour and decided to drive down from Meyerton to connect with us.






Thankfully the incident happened at the campsite and not 10 minutes later on the highway. The axle was repaired and Pat and Marlene joined up with us later that day.


















STRANDSKLOOF (15 - 17 SEPTEMBER 2023)


Friday saw the start of the official rally. Gelukkig beskik Strandskloof karavaanpark oor n vol toegeruste saal so die aktiwiteite wat




















Saturday evening we did manage to get the braai fires on, despite of the heavy winds and an enjoyable evening was enjoyed by everyone.



































GANZEKRAAL (23 - 28 OCTOBER 2023) - MIDWEEK



With much laughter and surprise it was Hannes and Elretha who the Rally Lucky.



Each evening, there were fires lit, and club members enjoyed leisurely braais and kuiers.






















FREE STATE REGION




The 13-inch refractor telescope at Boyden observatory.
