Meer hieroor in 'n volgende uitgawe.

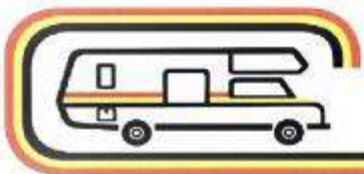

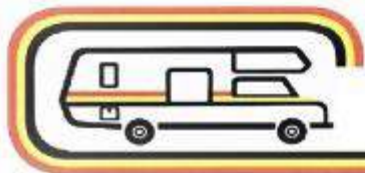

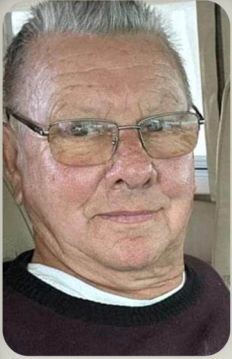

Our motorhome gets a well-earned rest at this time of year.

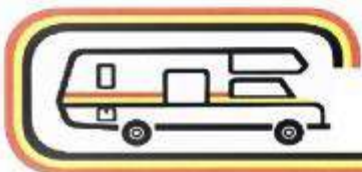

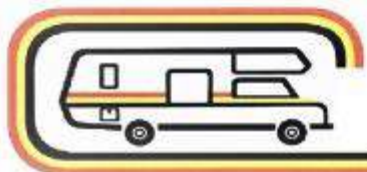
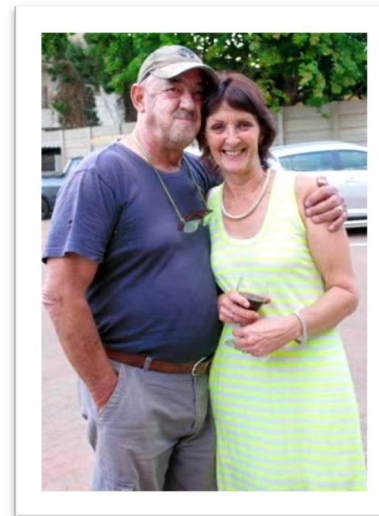
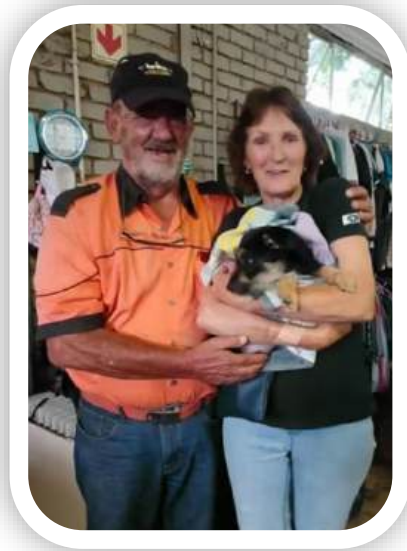
Peter was an avid motorhomer who always joined in all the fun and helpful in every way.

### Chairman's Report (2024-2025)

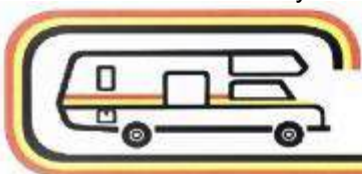

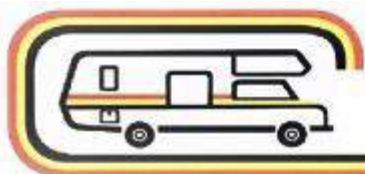
In closing I would like to extend my heartfelt the thanks to the following people:

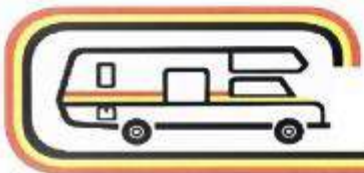


## INFORMATION CENTRE (3)

Just a few notes from our recent travels that you might find interesting.

Jill and I have had our VW mobile home from AC Motorhomes for a number of years now, probably more than 15. At the time we travelled around the country looking for a new van and were about to order one in the Cape when my brother in law spotted an advert for a new near one in Cape Town. Quick in the car and drive down to Cape Town, saw the van bought it for R500,000. We paid on line – a novelty in those days and started the drive home. That's when the difficulties started. Firstly it was mid afternoon on a Friday and the World was driving home for an early weekend (which I believe is normal). Then it started to get dark and the rain came. Then I found out the van only had one headlight, the airbag was leaking, and the van leaned something horrible. We managed to get as far as Matjiesfontein the Lord Milner Hotel. We have always wanted to stay there and having no bedding in the van and being dead on our feet we had little choice. Never again. It was the middle of winter, we were freezing. There did not seem to be any heating in the hotel, the beds were Victorian and the blankets were paper thin army grey blankets. I think we only managed until about 4 am and had to get back into the van to drive back to Bloemfontein, blessing the very effective heater. But that was years ago.

We bought the van mainly to attend Bulldog Shows and travelled all over the country as a result.



## INFORMATION CENTRE (3 continue)

In 2022 we sold our business and went into semi-retirement. For me that meant more time in the veggie garden but for Jill she has the wonderlust – yes we have driven to game parks in the far reaches of South Africa, even if we could not read the front door of upmarket bush hotels because of the front wheel drive slipping and have waded through 1 m deep flooded concrete bridges, thankfully guided by rangers in their Land Rovers – but we did make it.

Recently we drove to George to visit my brother in law and then went off the outdoor exhibition in Hartenbos (ATKV resort really clean, nice place to stay on the beach front). We saw a few new mobile homes based on Mercedes chassis. Too expensive for me at R2.2 million and not that practical. Not sure why everyone is building with outdoor kitchens, not my style. Being based on a van they are also very narrow inside.

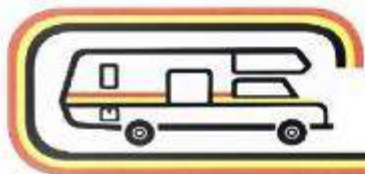
Then it was off to Hermans to the On Rus Caravan, again on the beach front, which when we were there was rather windy for a couple of days. Good clean facilities and easy drive down to see the Whales at Gansbaai. We were not the only mobile home and two parked opposite us. One was a nice new van a little bigger than ours again with the outdoor kitchen. But the other one was a huge truck from Saudi Arabia. Certainly a good viewing van but must have brushed every tree all the way there. Just look at the steps needed to get inside!

While we were there we went to look at a second hand WC Pacer that was for sale – only 1150 km. It was situated on a horse stud – they had just spent R28 million on upgrading the house. There were 170 mares valued between R2.5 and R6.5 million each. This is one of three farms that the family own. We were lucky to arrive just as a foal was born. The picture shows it getting its first feed. No we did not buy the van. While the size was just right, the quality of the woodwork and general condition of the van belied its low mileage. The owner had even changed the automatic box for a manual one. I am sure he is going to find it difficult to sell at the R650,000 he was looking for. I would consider a low mileage automatic one in good condition but did not feel happy with that one at all.

We drove back to Bloemfontein over two days stopping at Beaufort West because it got dark before we could get to the dam. Stayed in the first garage coming in, but wow it was noisy with constant truck movement. While older the last one before leaving town would have been much quieter.

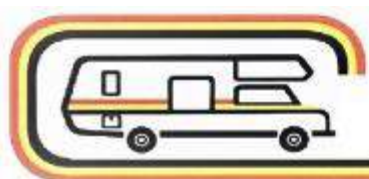
# FREE STATE REGION

Die dag is in ontspanne geselskap deurgebring en soos die son gesak het, het die lag en stories rondom die kampvuur tot laataand voortgeduur.

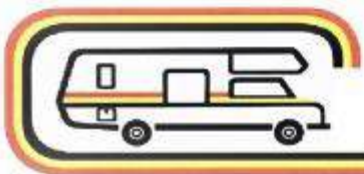
Die rustige atmosfeer en goeie geselskap het die dag besonders gemaak.

### **ROCKY BAY (17 - 19 OCTOBER 2025)**

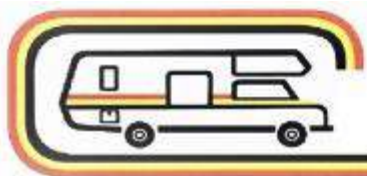
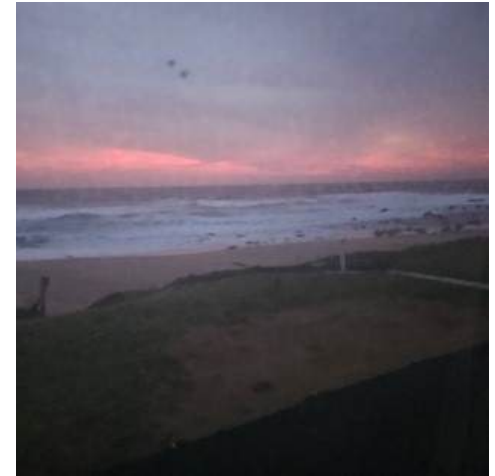

Vroeg oggend is daar van die lede wat die warm water swembad opsoek om die dag te begin, whilst others take a swift drive through the resort to do some game watching.

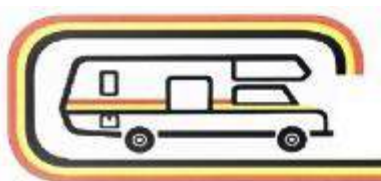

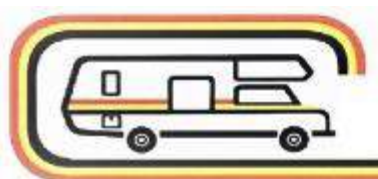
All Northvaal members proudly wear their Northvaal shirts making the event looking spectacular (if I may say so myself).

The afternoon, or what was left over after the activities and eats, was spend quietly with all making use of the resort's attractions.



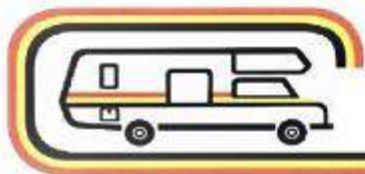

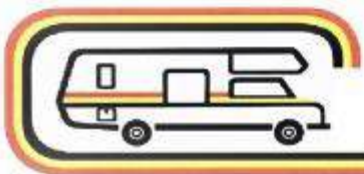
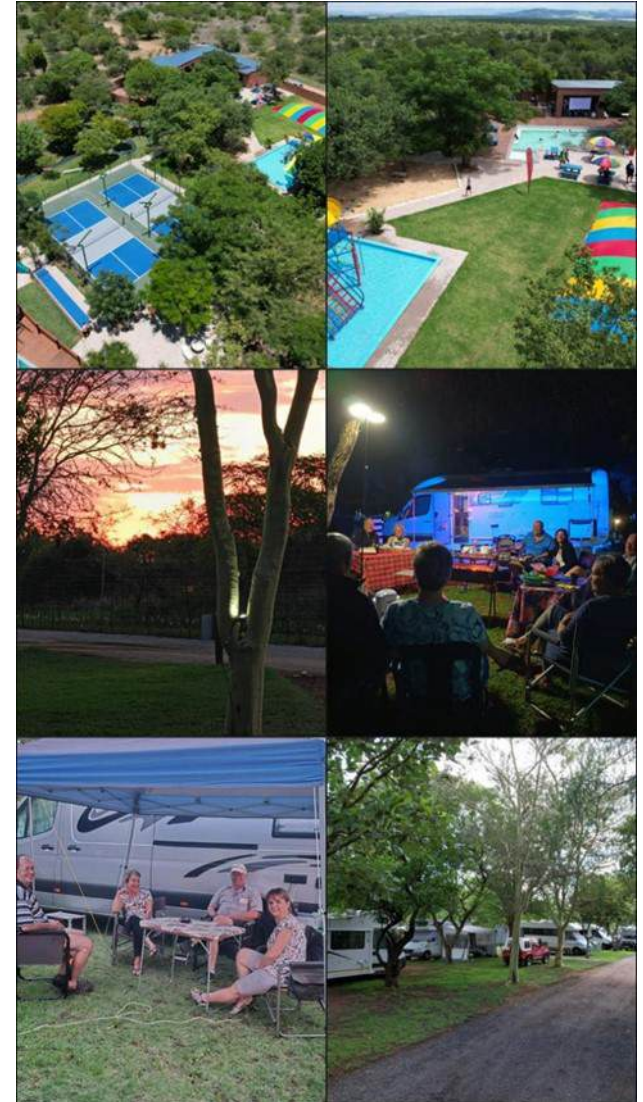
## ONVERWAGS (21 – 23 NOVEMBER 2025)

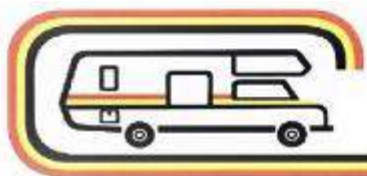

With the meet and greet on Friday Eddie Fourie (NV Chairman) welcomed everyone and explained what the next 2 days is going to consist of.



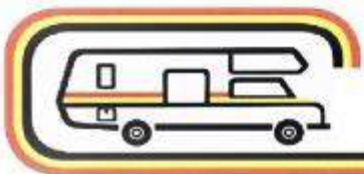

The dinner was a nice buffet prepared by the resort and supplied the music and “DJ Johan”

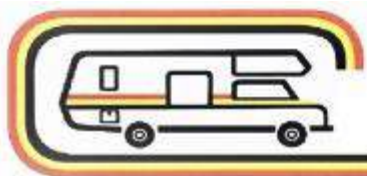

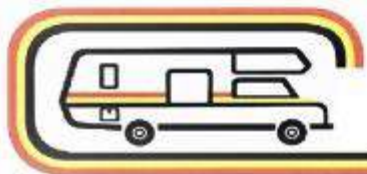
## **HAYWOODS GAME LODGE (DINOKENG) (5 - 7 DECEMBER 2025)**

Hein prepared fried eggs for all on the Saturday morning. All we had to do was arrive and enjoy a breakfast together.



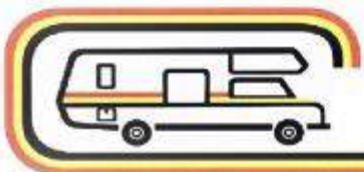

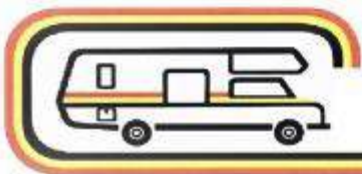

There was some serious Bolle games played during the week with nice prizes Sponsored by Motorhome World and Fiamma in Atlantis. Thanks Girls!

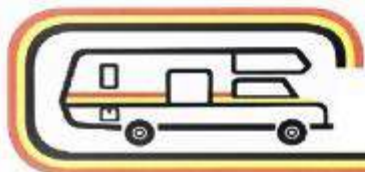

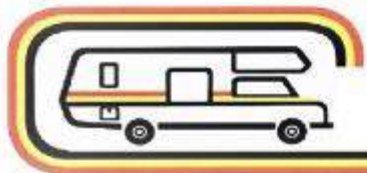
Friday nights bring and braai was a huge success. All the regions were well represented and everybody enjoyed themselves.

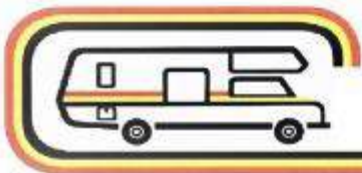


Our final camp of the year was held at the beautiful Ou Skip campsite in Melkbos.

Friday Evening – Bring & Braai and festive Lights Walk.

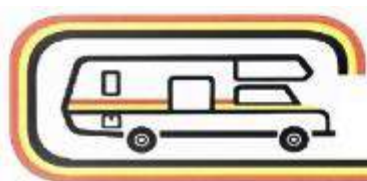

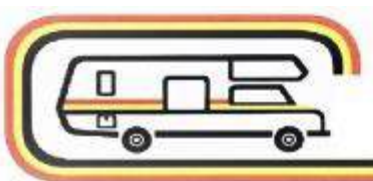
Saturday Morning – Election of the New Committee.

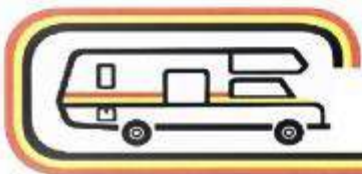

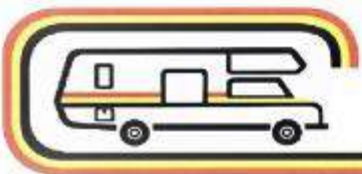
Best Decorated Motorhome – two prizes were awarded for outstanding creativity.
