Stuur gerus jul grappies en kampresepte, ek sal dit graag publiseer.

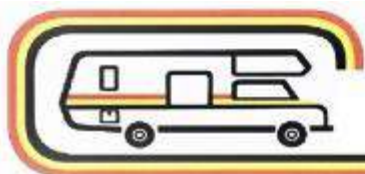

## CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

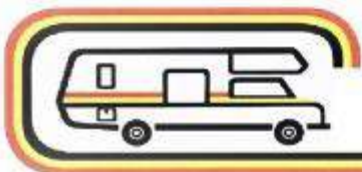

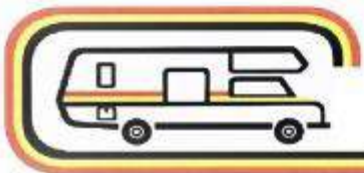
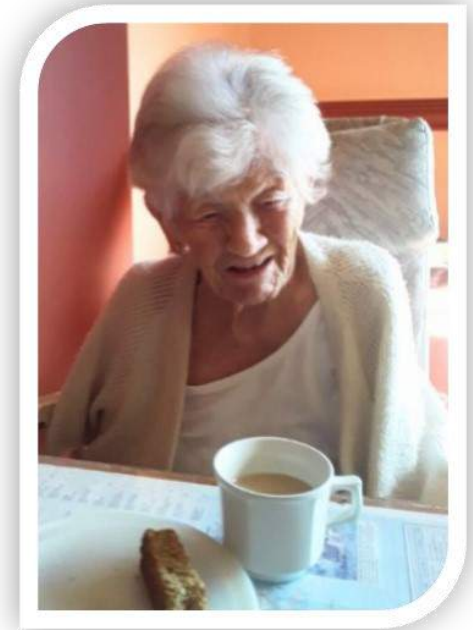
## OBITUARY

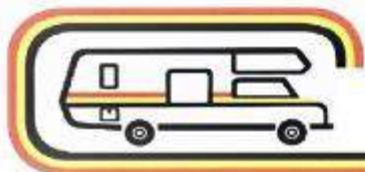
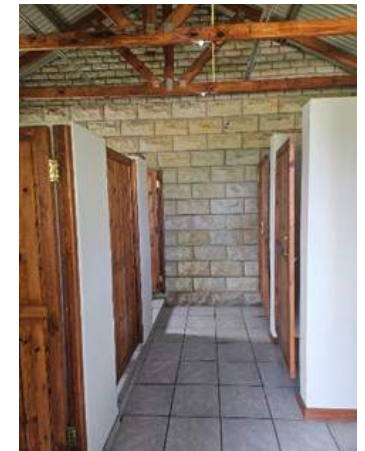
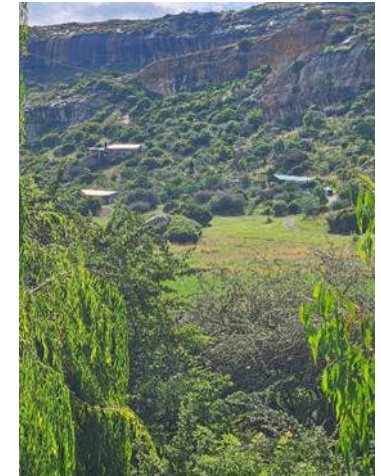


Die week kamp is gehou by Ulthoek Natuurpark tussen Bethlehem (42km) en Fouriesburg (10) met 'n 3km grondpad wat, ten spyte van die reën, goed onderhou word. Die kamp is bygewoon deur 13 ryhuise, en die kampeerders het tussen 4 en 7 dae gekamp soos dit hulle gepas het.

Daar kom 'n verskeidenheid wild op die plaas voor en daar is geleentheid vir aktiwiteite soos stap, abseil, zipline (foefieslide) en 4x4 roetes. Die kamp terrein is grasbedek, met verskeie lapas, swembad, 'n baie netjiese ablusie blok met 'n gesinsbadkamer. Daar is genoeg krag- en waterpunte en skoon drinkwater.

Uithoek se ligging leen hom goed daartoe om die asemrowende mooi Oos-Vrystaat te verken.

In die omgewing is vele besienswaardighede soos die uitlaat van die tunnel vanaf die Lesotho Hoogland waterskema in die Asrivier, die Golden Gate Nasionale Park, die mooie Clarens met al sy winkel en snuistrywinkeltjies. Om nie eers te praat van al die Restaurante wat deur die groep besoek is nie. Behalwe die mooi sandsteen berge is daar ook gedenkwaardige plekke wat besoek kan word. Destiny Castle is ook naby en kan op afspraak besoek word. Toegang is egter net moontlik met 'n 4x4 voertuig.

All in all a laughter filled weekend with fellow travellers.



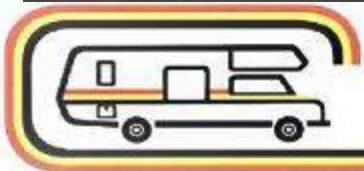

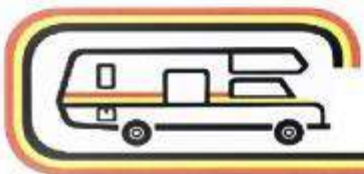

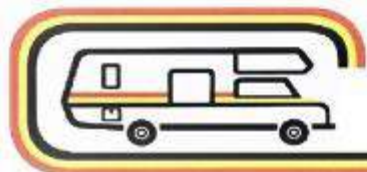
## **MOUNT PARK GUEST FARM, DARGLE (26 -28 JANUARY 2024)**

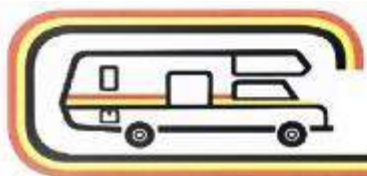

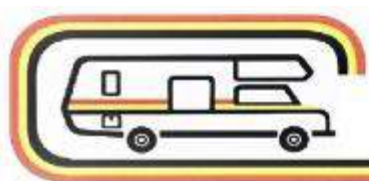

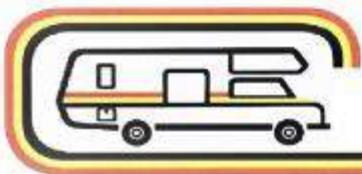

### LAKE UMUZI (24 - 26 NOVEMBER 2023) - CHRISTMAS RALLY

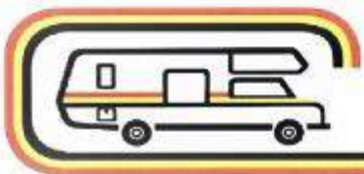

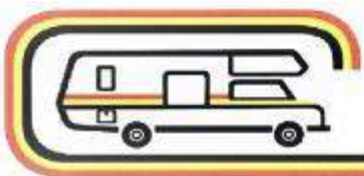
Friday evening was concluded with a successful bring-and-braai, which was well supported, despite it being out-of-character for a Friday evening, as some members told the secretary!

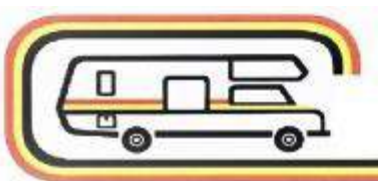
Nicolien and John hard at work.

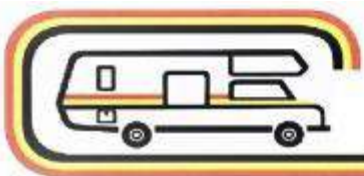

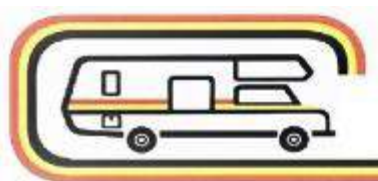

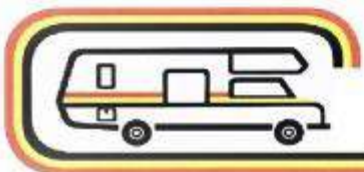

Early birders did the final cleaning and preparation Sunday morning, for the 09:00 Devotion, led by Jay Bezuidenhout.

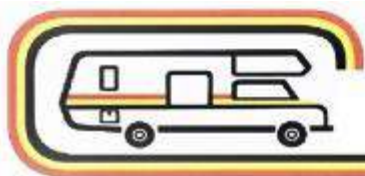
After Devotion, the Chairman's tea followed.

It was a really great weekend to mark the end of another successful rally year.



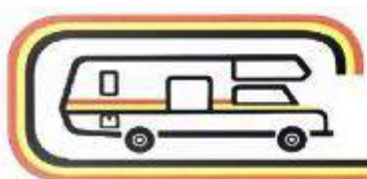

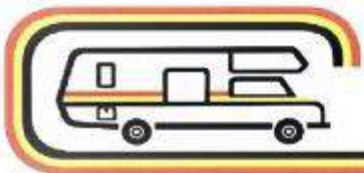
Karel and Ansie reached their 50th rally, and Jay presented them with a certificate and a token, as well as printed mugs with some special photos.

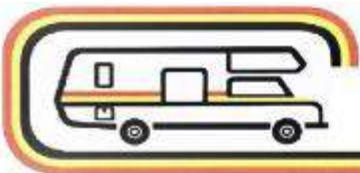
## **RIETSPRUITDAM (19 - 21 JANUARY 2024)**

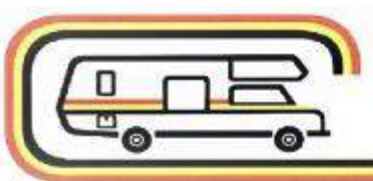
The wooden spoon was presented up-side to Erina for her enjoyment of all the full-size mirrors in the showers!!

## KAIA MANZI (16 - 18 FEBRUARY 2024)

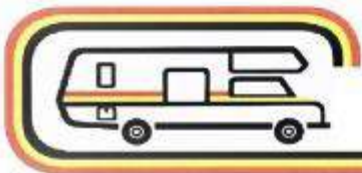

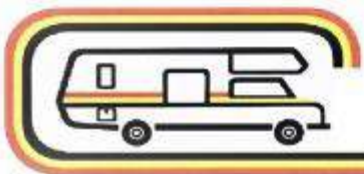

Tea and eats were thereafter enjoyed by all.



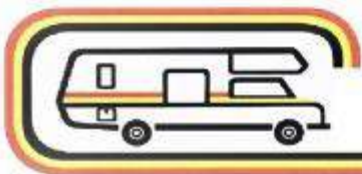

# WESTERN CAPE REGION

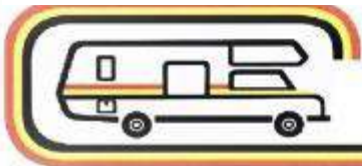
SKURWEKOP, ROBERTSON (26 - 28 JANUARY 2024)

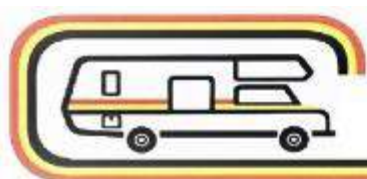

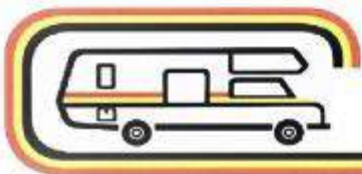

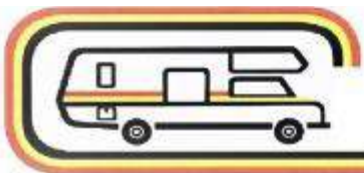
Willie thanked Athna and the Committee for a wonderful Rally and for all the hard work, dedication, and initiative.

Normally we would start a report at the beginning of a rally. But what a way to end a super fantastic rally.

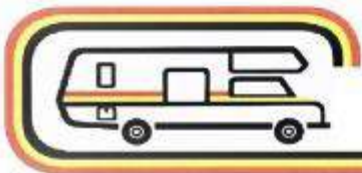
