





We are looking forward to the National convergence rally which will take place during October this year at Gariep. It will be the 40th anniversary of the club and preparations have already started.


We are also organising a bowls rally to Gariep. More info will be sent out shortly.



VRYDAG MIDDAG "MEET & GREET"








ARCH ROCK

VRYDAG AAND



Heerlike Put-Put baan onder koelte bome vir almal om te geniet.


Tydens ons heerlike kamp is daar ook besluit om die Kersfunksie van die Vrystaat-streek by Umfula te kom hou.

The resort boasted an outdoor chess area (I don't think anyone made use of this either) but the pool tables were utilised on the Saturday as were the table tennis tables again.


The weather was kind enough to allow us to have a lovely outdoor braai on Saturday evening. I have to say our evenings are becoming longer and longer as the months go by!

ourselves and several members went back for seconds. Thanks Bob and Vani, your curries are delicious!




and luckily rain held off until much later when most people had gone back into their vans.

After a few late afternoon lawn games and with the chill of the coming winter in the air, a wonderful evening was spent braaing and socialising around the firepit.



Skukuza: 17 May – The end is in sight



The Friday Meet & Greet was led by Dawid Mouton, our new chairman. It is always a happy event, especially seeing all present and catching up with news.


The birthdays of Dawid Mouton, Val Swanepoel and Philip van der Merwe were celebrated.

Bloekompoort staff. At R50 a head we were treated to a scrumptious








Thereafter we had devotions where Linda McDougall gave us an insightful message on Prayer. As we just had breakfast, the Chairman led us straight to the closing comments.



On Thursday 7 members joined Ari for an enjoyable morning of bowls at the Brits bowling club.


Thursday evening the traditional bring and braai was held and the "kuier" went on and on. A very enjoyable evening to end our midweek.



At 10 o'clock management of Onverwags treated us with the most divine cupcakes. What a spoil!





KRUGER NATIONAL PARK (6 - 12 MAY 2024)






Badplaas for an overnight before we go home.



The motor homers started departing in their own directions except for a few that stayed on for a day or 3 longer.






On Tuesday 16 April 17 Motorhomes gathered at Riggton for our mid-week rally before we join the Garden route MHC for their monthly rally.
